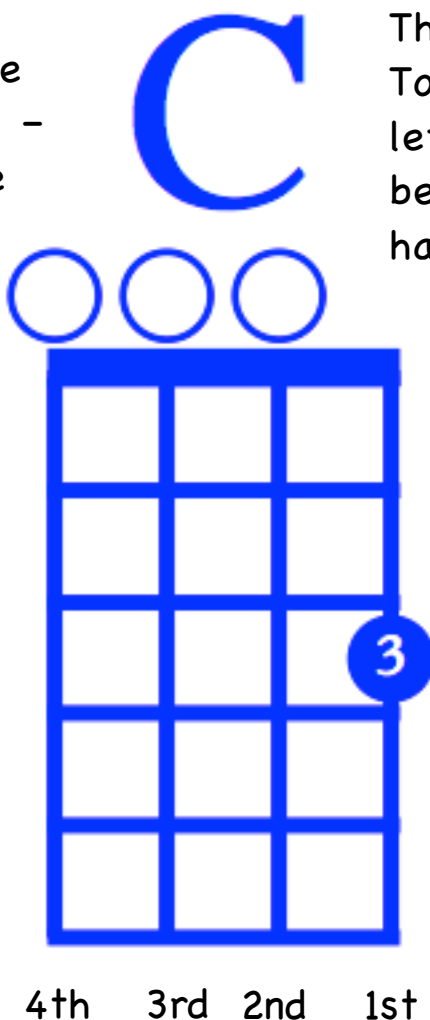


How to Read Chord Boxes

These circles mean the string is played *Open* - with no fingers on the frets.

This is the name of the chord. The chord shown is *C Major*. To show a minor chord the letter would have a small *m* beside it. A seventh chord would have a *7* beside it.



This Dot is where to put your finger. The number is what left hand finger to use.

Frets are the spaces between the lines going across the Ukulele. To play this chord you put your finger on the string at the 3rd Fret.

- 1 = index (pointing) finger
- 2 = middle finger
- 3 = ring finger
- 4 = little finger

The 1st string is nearest the floor when you hold your Ukulele in the playing position
