

# How to Read Tablature (TAB)

TAB is a way of showing you where individual notes and chords are on the Ukulele.

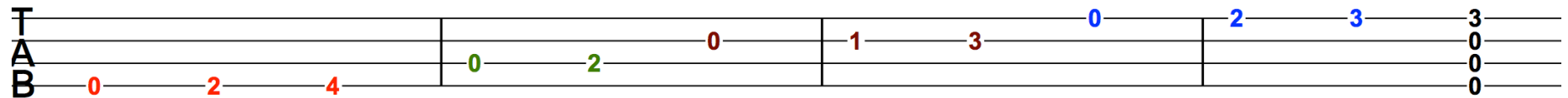
The Lines across the page are the strings of the Ukulele.

The **bottom line** of the TAB is the string **nearest your nose** when you hold the Ukulele in the playing position. This is the **4th string or G string**.

The next line up is the **3rd string or C string**.

The next line up is the **2nd string or E string**.

The **top line** of the TAB is the string **nearest the floor** when you hold the Ukulele in the playing position. This is **1st string or A string**.



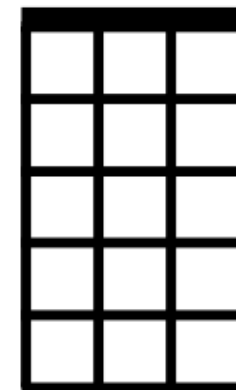
**0** means pluck the **4th string** with no left hand fingers.

**2** means pluck the **4th string** with a left hand finger at **fret 2**.

**4** means pluck the **4th string** with a left hand finger at **fret 4**.

**0** means pluck the **3rd string** with no left hand fingers. **2** means pluck the **3rd string** with a left hand finger at **fret 2**.
